In our VUCA world, new and fresh ways of being and doing are urgently needed if we are to re-imagine and co-create different futures which can bring us into wholeness and contribute to healing our fragmented world.

Beyond yesterday's logic and our traditional tools, a compassionate whole hearted creativity is the new meta skill which can free us from the past patterns and paradigms which are no longer serving us – either individually or collectively. This is the place where we can remember to connect to the vast warp and weft of possibility and potential which is naturally inherent in us and in nature and from which we can weave new tapestries of hope, possibility, meaning, wisdom and agency whatever our role or context.



Who is the Programme for?

The programme is for any leader, coach, supervisor, people professional and creative spirit who wants to inhabit the rich holistic field of whole hearted creativity as an intentional attention to our way of being and working in today's VUCA world. It is for anyone who wants to go on a profound inner journey in order to cultivate their creativity and understand the unique choreography of their own creative process and who is looking for the next stage in the dance of their personal and professional development. It is for anyone who wants to step into ways of being that help to thread learning, growth and wisdom into the very fabric of who they are whilst inspiring others to do the same.

What Is the Design of the Programme?

The programme is fun, experiential, experimental and reflective. The Diploma is grounded in the joy of connection, learning, discovery and artisanship.

Participants take a triple track approach exploring their own creative self, finding their own creative self expression and shaping their own creative identity whilst studying the intricacies of the creative process and also applying their learning to a work based project or case study of their choosing over the 12 months.

The 12 month programme journeys through the 6 creative thresholds of Preparation, Connection, Inspiration, Rejuvenation, Conservation and Harvesting to Exhibition and Celebration

and is set against the changing seasons of the year.

We start with the premise that everyone is an "A" star student. We will use a fresh process of dynamic inquiry and creative self reflection for ongoing personal learning during the programme. We will use a co-created dynamic peer review inquiry process to conclude and confirm successful completion of the programme for everyone.

Each bi-monthly threshold will be explored through a beautifully curated fusion of artistic, musical, somatic, mindfulness, poetical, nature-based, and reflective journaling practices. Self study will be woven in with alternate monthly Community Salons and Studio Webinar Presentations on Zoom. In addition you will form into trios for monthly virtual Café Gatherings, and you also will supported by two virtual reflective 1:1's sessions with a member of Faculty mid way and towards the end of the programme. The 12 month Practitioner Diploma Programme is made up of 162 hours of study time (which equates to about 3 hours a week) and over its duration will be a seamless blend of 60% skills practice, 25% reflection, 25% theory and models and 10% planned processes to meet the EMCC Global EQA guidelines for accredited courses.

We chose the metaphor of the craft of weaving because for us it holds the changing dynamic processes you will encounter and experience at each threshold as you spiral into an ever deepening alignment and connection to your intention, humanity and potency.

The programme builds on the latest research and thinking in such diverse spheres as relational dynamics, adult learning, mindfulness, psychology, creativity, nature and the arts.

The total programme is made up of

- 6 x 2 hour Community Salons
- 8 x 75 minute Studio Webinars - the 1st and last as Opening and Closing Circles and the rest with guest speakers for each Module
- 7 PDF Workbooks containing reading lists and a range of exercises, practices and reflective questions
- 6 Podcasts
- 6 Café Trios
- 2 x one hour reflective 1:1 Sessions with Faculty
- Application of learning to a work based project of your choice
- 3 x Self Assessments
- Ongoing creative reflection and journaling or sketchbook and photo journaling practices
- Portfolio assessed by a dynamic peer review process
